

District 2-A1 2024 Constitution & By-Laws Resolution

Whereas the District 2-A1 Constitution & By-Laws has not been updated by amendment since July 1, 2017; and

Whereas the LCI Standard Constitution & By-Laws has been updated and amended several times since July 1, 2017; and

Whereas the Ad Hoc Committee, chaired by the District Parliamentarian and consisting of the District Governor & all active Past District Governors, was formed to review, update, and bring into compliance with LCI, the 2-A1 Constitution & By-Laws; and

Whereas the Ad Hoc Committee has completed their work; and

Whereas the changes made by LCI to the Standard District Constitution & By-Laws are too numerous to make through a series of amendments to the current 2-A1 document; and

Whereas the Committee offers the attached NEW Constitution & By-Laws for consideration by the Lions of District 2-A1 to completely replace the July 1, 2017 document in its entirety; and


Whereas the document offered uses all wording required by Lions Clubs International in the newest LCI Standard District Constitution template, but incorporates special wording specific to District 2-A1 to the extent it does not conflict with Lions Clubs International; and

Whereas this final document has been approved by the Ad Hoc Committee with the recommendation that the new Constitution & By-Laws be put to a vote of the Lions of District 2-A1 for implementation as of July 1, 2024; and

Whereas the Committee certifies that this document will be voted on as presented here with the exception that minor corrections, typos, misspellings, etc. that DO NOT change the meaning of the document will be made if discovered prior to the vote; and that no material changes will be made without first submitting such information to the Clubs prior to the voting.

Be it resolved, therefore, that the new Constitution & By-Laws for District 2-A1 be placed on the ballot at the 2024 District Convention to be voted on by all certified delegates.
