Wow! It's hard to believe that another Lions year is almost over. Time flies when one is having fun.

First off I would like to thank all of our Lions who has made this a successful and joyful year for District 2-A1 . To our District staff are clubs officers and most of all the frontline Lions who are out there serving our communities every day I would like to say good job and well done!

I'm proud to report the we have had a successful year. Much service was accomplished this year in the areas of vision, disaster relief, membership growth and serving the special and everyday needs of our West Texas communities.

I'm very proud of the Midland Lions who have stepped up in a time of need to re-vamp and move the TLERC forward into a new era. I'm also very proud of how our district came together to support the communities affected by the wildfires. Over \$5,000 worth of goods was raised for the victims as well as \$1,000 from the Midland West Side Lions Club and an additional \$3,000 from the Texas Lions Foundation.

And also I am very proud of our membership growth this year which is (at the time of writing) +90. Which breaks down as follows: we started the year with 967 members , we added 234 new members and dropped 144 for a total of 90 . The district currently has 1,057 members. And new members coming in all the time. Midland downtown is currently adding five new members! Through the efforts of PDG Keith Perrine 9 clubs were removed from cancellations at the beginning of the year. And I, working with the club officers, was able to remove one more from cancellation and added 13 new members to the club in the process. MD-2 is +544 new members which will increase our service exponentially.

And I'm also very proud of the everyday service that our clubs have done that does not always make the headlines but is just as important is all the other things that have been accomplished.

At this time I would like to take the opportunity to wish our new District Governor Lion Carole Ann Brown all the success in the world during her upcoming governor year. As well as all the incoming club officers and all Lions. I know together as a team we will move District 2-A1 into a successful new Lions year and a successful future.

And once again I would like to thank all of the Lions who have made my year a successful and joyful experience!

There is a program growing for collecting plastic bottle caps/lids (NO containers or bottles).

It DID NOT begin in San Angelo at our Charities Building but we have become the collection site for them. So supposedly for every 1000 bottle caps/lids we collect and send to Mexico 1 child receives a cancer treatment. The bottle caps/lids are then sent to a plant in Mexico where they make toys out of them.

This is not a scam as we have been participating in this effort for quite some time now.

This is what Lions do, WE SERVE, whenever and wherever possible for whatever cause benefits others.

We are asking anyone who donates those bottle caps/lids to please make sure they are in boxes. If they can be put in sealed plastic bags BEFORE they are put in the boxes even better.

That way while in transit to Mexico they cannot spill out all over the highway as they are going down the road.

Right now our warehouse is full of the bottle caps and we are waiting for the person who comes and picks them up for transport to come and get them.

This is more than a pickup load and needs to be soon as we are running out of space fast. On Saturday evening, May 21, 2022, a trailer full was unloaded outside our back door when no one was there. During a meeting the following Monday night we realized they were there and covered them with a tarp before the rain hit that night. We were fortunate enough to get them in the building and in dry boxes on Tuesday before the storm hit on Tuesday evening.

If donating and putting them in our drop box please also make sure they are in a sealed bag so they do not spill.

Ever had to pick up 100's of bottle caps off the floor.

Sign Up, Step Up, Catch Up



For Century Club - It's "Service from the Heart"

If you aren't a member of the TLC Century Club, please "Sign Up"; if you are a member, consider "Stepping Up" to the next level; and if you were a member but dropped out, consider "Catching Up" (i.e., come back in).

What is Texas Lions Camp Century Club? It's an individual annual giving program, and as such, it is giving from your own heart, independent of Club budgets or fund raisers. It is one of the life bloods of our operating budget, that in normal times sends 1500 children with special needs to Texas Lions Camp every year, and yet less than 5% of Texas Lions are members.

Who can be a Century Club Member? Anyone can be a member. You don't have to be a Lion. It can be family or friends. You can even be a non-Texan, but it is our Texas Lions who are the backbone of the Century Club.

What does it cost to be a member? You can give your gift annually, or you can give monthly. A Bronze member is \$100 (\$10 if monthly); Silver is \$250; Gold \$500; Diamond is \$1,000; & Ambassador is \$5,000. Membership automatically renews each year, so members should join with the intention of making their same gift each year or even increasing their level.

How do I enroll or Step Up? Go to www.lionscamp.com, click on "Get Involved" and go to "Donate Now". There you will find "Ways to Give". Click that open and select "Century Club". If you scroll down, you will see the option to enroll online or to download and print out the form to send to the Camp directly.

Sign Up, Step Up, Catch Up is a 3-year drive to beef up our Century Club membership for the Texas Lions Camp, as a birthday present to Texas Lions Camp on its 75th Anniversary in 2024. Today we have half the number of Texas Lions, supporting twice the number of campers at twice the cost, as we did some 30 years ago. If we reach our goal of **2 new Century Club members/club/year** over the next 3 Lions years, we will generate an additional annual income of \$500,000, which would generate 15% of our operating budget, and help us keep serving our special children into the future.

Two per Club (6 over 3 years) is doable. "Signing Up" as a new Bronze member at \$10/mo. (\$120/yr.) counts as one; but a new Silver (\$250) counts as 2; Gold (\$500) is the same as 4 Bronze; etc. Likewise, "Stepping Up" from Bronze to Silver counts as a +1; Bronze to Gold adds the equivalent of 3 new Bronzes; going from Silver to Gold is the same as 2 new Bronzes, etc.

\$500,000/year – now that's some 75th Birthday present!

There's a saying at TLC that "ALL CAN DO". Yes, Texas Lions, 2/Club/Yr. WE CAN DO IT.
